Chairman Schiff outlines the 4 questions of his investigation

- 1. Did Trump seek foreign assistance for an election?
- 2. Was the meeting sought by the Ukrainian government conditioned on the Ukraine investigation of Vice President Biden and his son?
- 3. Was military assistance withheld until confirmation that the investigation would occur?
- 4. Were these issues covered up by the Trump administration?
