"In the course of my official duties, I have received information from multiple U.S. Government officials that the President of the United States is using the power of his office to solicit interference from a foreign country in the 2020 U.S. election"

Chairman Schiff outlines the 4 questions of his investigation

1. Did Trump seek foreign assistance for an election?
2. Was the meeting sought by the Ukrainian government conditioned on the Ukraine investigation of Vice President Biden and his son?
3. Was military assistance withheld until confirmation that the investigation would occur?
4. Were these issues covered up by the Trump administration?
